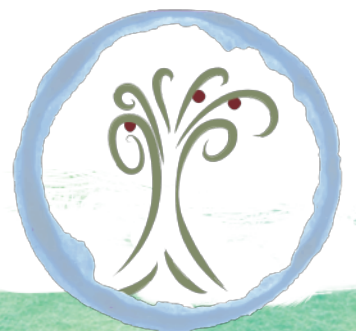
This work may be included in your circles, festivals, movement journeys, parent nights or as transitional pieces throughout the day with the children.
