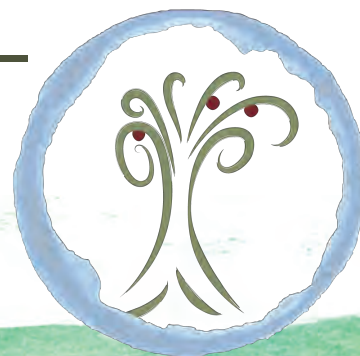


Join us for a morning of fingerplays and movement games that will create a harmonious and joyful atmosphere for your children.
